

SET OF RULES

1. Membership fees for Harefield Gymnastics must be paid annually on 1st September for Squad gymnasts and termly for recreational gymnastics classes, this must be paid to be eligible to participate in competitions, award schemes and club activities
2. Coaching fees for recreational gymnastics classes must be paid in accordance with the invoice for the term, any late payments will incur an administration fee
3. Squad coaching fees must be made with London & Zurich via the club database on the 2nd of every month with payments pre-authorized in advance
4. All members must be affiliated to the British Gymnastics Association, the fee of which must be paid by 30th September every year or upon joining us.
5. Appropriate clothing must be worn, recreational gymnasts should purchase the club leotard from the online store by visiting www.harefieldgymnastics.com
6. No necklaces, bracelets or earrings are to be worn during training sessions.
7. Long hair must be tied up, away from the face
8. Gymnasts must be courteous at all times to other gymnasts and coaching staff and treat others as they would like to be treating themselves. Bullying will not be tolerated
9. Gymnasts must listen to the coaching staff and follow instructions
10. Gymnasts are not to use any equipment unless instructed to do so by a coach
11. Gymnasts are to treat the gym, changing room and the equipment with care and consideration. This includes putting any rubbish in the bin
12. No shoes are allowed in the gymnasium at any time
13. No food or drink is to be consumed by the gymnasts in the gym
14. If any parent feels they may be late collecting their child from the gym, they must contact the coach at the earliest opportunity using the emergency contact details provided upon joining
15. Every child must wait inside the gym building to be collected. Under no circumstances should a child leave the building without their parent or guardian
16. Any parent that has a matter they wish to discuss regarding their child should make an appointment with the appropriate club coach
17. Decisions regarding partnerships are at the sole decision of the coaching team and parental involvement/influencing behaviours are not acceptable
18. Any concerns should be raised in the appropriate manner with the appropriate coach and gossip and rumours between parents will not be tolerated
19. Any wilful damage to club property will result in appropriate action being taken against the individual concerned
20. Harefield Gymnastics & Dance are non-discriminatory and open to all participants regardless of sex, race, religion, ethnic background or origin, and operates an open-door policy. Due to the size of the gymnasium parents are not permitted inside, however opportunities will be provided throughout the year to watch training
